SUBJECT: Medicaid Works Income Limit Increase Effective July 1, 2021

Effective July 1, 2021, the income limit for admission into the Medicaid Works program is 138% of the Federal Poverty Level. Medical Assistance Transmittal DMAS-20, available at <https://www.dmas.virginia.gov/for-applicants/eligibility-guidance/broadcasts-and-transmittals/>, contains revised policy regarding the income limit increase.

We anticipate an increase in interest in Medicaid Works based on the new income limit. The Medicaid Works Agreement, Fact Sheet, and Information Guide have been revised to reflect the new income limit. When an individual is enrolled in Medicaid Works, a copy of the Medicaid Works Agreement, WIN account verification, and employment verification must be sent to the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) for our records.
