SUPPORT Act Grant Background

DMAS was awarded the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Substance Use Disorder Prevention that Promotes Opioid Recovery and Treatment for Patients and Communities (SUPPORT) Act Section 1003 Grant in September 2019. The purpose of this grant is to decrease substance use disorder (SUD) provider workforce barriers and increase the treatment capacity of providers participating under the state Medicaid program to provide SUD treatment or recovery services. While also recognizing the new barriers SUD providers are experiencing during the COVID-19 state of emergency, DMAS, through the SUPPORT Act Grant, is offering technical assistance and training webinars focused on substance use disorder-related topics and treatment practices.

Webinar Mission Statement

These technical assistance and training webinars are designed to increase SUD knowledge and to provide support to anyone who serves Medicaid members with substance use disorders. The overall goal of the webinars, as well as other grant activities, is to increase addiction and recovery workforce capacity while also creating a culture of understanding, empathy, and support for individuals with substance use disorder in various workforce settings.
