Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services COMMUNITY LIVING (CL) WAIVER FACT SHEET 2025

What is CL Waiver?

The Community Living (CL) Waiver [1915 (c)] provides care in the home and community rather than in an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disability (ICF/IID) or other specialized care medical facility. CL waiver is managed jointly between DMAS and DBHDS. DMAS is the state Medicaid Authority and DBHDS maintains day-to-day operations for the DD Waivers. The CL waiver is for children and adults who usually require supports in their homes all the time. Individuals may need to access residential supports and some people may need to live in these homes with staff to receive supports with complex medical and/or behavioral needs.

Eligible Population

For children and adults who:

- Meet the ICF/IID level of care criteria:
- Require waiver services within 30 days
- Have a diagnosis of a developmental disability.

 Be determined that community-based services under the waiver are the critical services that enable the individual to delay or avoid placement in an ICF or promote exiting from either an ICF or other institutional placement.
