More than 87% of members




## Medicaid Delivery System

Cardinal Care Managed Care (CCMC) is Virginia's Medicaid & FAMIS managed care program.




## Cardinal Care Managed Care Rollout

Cardinal Care Managed Care (CCMC) was launched in January 2023 to enhance Virginia's Medicaid managed care system. Through the program, Virginia:

- Consolidated the two previous managed care programs into CCMC
   Commonwealth Coordinated Care Plus & Medallion 4.0
- 2. Defined transformation goals for the program.
- 3. Reprocured (re-selected and re-contracted) managed care health plans to improve the CCMC delivery system and better serve members.
  - Including the selection of a single statewide **Foster Care Specialty Plan** from among the newly contracted health plans.
    - New Cardinal Care Managed Care contracts will be effective July 1, 2025

## Foster Care Specialty Plan



**Anthem HealthKeepers Plus** has been selected to administer a single statewide Foster Care Specialty Plan (FCSP) under the Cardinal Care Managed Care Contract.

✓ Youth involved in the child welfare system are at higher risk for certain health conditions and are subject to a variety of health-related social needs.

✓ Ensuring timely access to a comprehensive & coordinated array of services is key to improving outcomes.

✓ The Foster Care Specialty Plan was designed to meet the unique medical and behavioral needs of these vulnerable members, with value-added benefits to support reunification, education, employment, and more.



## Success Story: Texas STAR Health

In 2008, Texas was the first state to establish a Medicaid managed care program specifically for children in foster care. Like Virginia's Foster Care Specialty Plan, <u>STAR Health</u> was designed to better coordinate the health care of children in foster care through one statewide MCO.

## Foster Care Specialty Plan: Eligibility

#### Who is eligible?

# Foster Care AC 076

IV-E and non IV-E

- "24-hour substitute care for children placed away from their parents or guardians and for whom the Title IV-E agency has placement and care responsibility."
- Children in foster care are eligible for Medicaid unless they are not Virginia residents, or they have financial resources that make them ineligible.

# Adoption Assistance AC 072

IV-E and non IV-E

- Determined by each individual Adoption Assistance Agreement
- Includes health insurance through the Medicaid program for an eligible child under age 21 receiving adoption assistance.

# Former Foster Care AC 070

- An individual under 26 who was in the custody of DSS in any U.S. state and receiving Medicaid until discharge from foster care upon turning age 18 years or older.
- This includes individuals over 18 in an IL arrangement or Fostering Futures Program through DSS.




#### Current Enrollment: Foster Care, Adoption Assistance, & Former Foster Care

**16,567** children and youth are enrolled in Medicaid through Foster Care, Adoption Assistance, & Former Foster Care eligibility.

- 5,500 in foster care
- 8,775 in adoption assistance
- 2,292 in former foster care


#### **Transition Timeline**



- ✓ All eligible members will automatically enroll into Anthem's Foster Care Specialty Plan (FCSP) on their region's enrollment date, and do not need to take any action.
- ✓ Mailings: Members will receive a flyer telling them about the changes before FCSP Assignment, and another letter before FCSP Enrollment.
- ✓ Foster Care Specialty Plan enrollment will occur in **two phases** based on <u>region</u>\*



## Local DSS Role: Medicaid Eligibility & Enrollment

The Department of Social Services (DSS) is an essential partner in ensuring all youth in foster care, adoption assistance, and former foster care are able to access appropriate medical & behavioral health care services.

#### To ensure a smooth transition and ongoing support:


- All members eligible for Foster Care (AC 076), Adoption Assistance (AC 072), and Former Foster Care (AC 070) **must be** enrolled by their local DSS into these aid categories so they can be accurately identified & enrolled into the FCSP.
- All VaCMS Demographic Information must be up to date and accurate for member and DSS worker.

## Continuity of Care



# 'Continuity of Care' requirements protect a member's care from interruption when they change health plans

The new health plan must:

- Allow the member to see their current provider for up to 30 days, even if the provider is not in the new health plan's provider network
- Honor service plan authorizations issued by DMAS or the previous health plan for the length of the authorization or 30 days, whichever is shorter
- Extend these timeframes as needed to ensure the member does not experience interruption in care
  - The new health plan may contract with the member's provider or help the member develop a safe and effective transition to an innetwork provider



## Foster Care Specialty Plan: Opt-Out Requests



- Members will be able to request to <u>Opt-Out</u> of the Foster Care Specialty Plan.
  - Members can Opt-Out or back in at any time
- Opt-Out requests made on or before the 18<sup>th</sup> are effective the first of the upcoming month and requests made after the 18<sup>th</sup> are effective the first of the month following the upcoming month.
- Opt-Out requests are made through the Enrollment Broker (also known as the Managed Care Helpline).
  - This will be the same process for members and guardians as current MCO change requests.

### Foster Care Specialty Plan: Opt-Out Requests



#### **Opt-Out Requests**

Foster Care AC 076

- Foster Care (AC 076) members who Opt-Out of the Foster Care Specialty Plan (FCSP) are no longer eligible for managed care and may only otherwise receive Medicaid benefits through the Fee-for-Service (FFS) delivery system.
- The **LDSS Foster Care Case Worker** listed as the Authorized Representative can request to Opt-Out of/In to the FCSP for a Foster Care (AC 076) member.
- Authorized Representative information must be verified with our Enrollment Broker via the Managed Care Helpline, so requests to Opt-Out <u>cannot</u> be made for youth in foster care using the Cardinal Care mobile app or website.
  - ✓ Authorized Representative is determined by the information entered into VaCMS by the local DSS agency.
  - ✓ In VaCMS, Household Address screen should include the DSS foster care worker listed in the "Attn/Care of" line. Alternate Payee screen should reflect the DSS foster care worker as the Authorized Representative.
  - ✓ Authorized Representatives must call the Managed Care Helpline to request to Opt-Out.

## Foster Care Specialty Plan: Opt-Out Requests



#### **Opt-Out Requests**

**Adoption Assistance** AC 072

Former Foster Care AC 070

- Adoption Assistance (AC 072) and former foster care (AC 070) members who Opt-Out of the Foster Care Specialty Plan (FCSP) will remain in managed care and will be required to select a different MCO.
  - ✓ If an Adoption Assistance (AC 072) or former foster care (AC 070) member has Opted-Out, they may also change their MCO at any time.
- Former Foster Care (AC 070) members may Opt-Out of or Opt-In to the FCSP themselves.
- Adoptive parents can Opt-Out of or Opt-In to the FCSP for members in Adoption Assistance (AC 072).
  - ✓ The local DSS agency must ensure the adoptive family's name is listed in VaCMS.
  - ✓ In VaCMS, Household Address screen should include the adoptive parent listed in the "Attn/Care of" line.
- Opt-Out, Opt-In, and MCO change requests can be made through the Enrollment Broker using the Virginia Cardinal Care app, the VirginiaManagedCare.com website, or by calling the Managed Care Helpline.

## Recap: Foster Care Specialty Plan (FCSP)



#### What is changing?



Anthem's Foster Care Specialty Plan will cover all eligible members statewide.



All eligible members will be automatically enrolled into the Foster Care Specialty Plan beginning July 1, 2025.



After the initial transition to Anthem, members will have the choice to Opt-Out\* of the FCSP.

- Foster Care: to Fee-For-Service
- Adoption Assistance & Former Foster Care: may select a different managed care health plan.
- Opt-Out requests can be directed to the Managed Care Helpline.

#### What is staying the same?


 Medicaid eligibility and enrollment: Youth will continue to be enrolled in Medicaid as long as they remain eligible.

One managed care program, one contract.

- Benefits and Services:
   Benefits will not be
   interrupted or reduced as
   long as the individual
   remains eligible for
   Medicaid.
- Newly enrolled Medicaid members will be in FFS for a short time prior to enrollment in a health plan.

## DMAS Foster Care Program Oversight

- Designated agency liaison for foster care and adoption assistance members leads program innovation through the development, implementation, and monitoring of health care initiatives and stakeholder collaboration.
- DMAS analyzes monthly reports from MCOs for contract compliance and trending. MCOs report Assessment completion, outreach, care coordination activities, and medical and behavioral health care service utilization.
- Designated DMAS Foster Care inbox for addressing and responding to inquiries and case management assistance: fostercare@dmas.virginia.gov
- DMAS facilitates Foster Care Partnership meetings and other trainings around the state to share information and develop actionable ideas, projects, and resources to better meet the needs of children in foster care.



#### **Educational Milestone Program**

Eligible members, ages 11–18, who receive a GPA of 2.5 or higher during a semester in the current school year receive one \$25 gift card per school year.

#### **Family Game Night**

Members ages 5-18 can select a package: Family Movie Night with a \$50 movie and restaurant gift card, or Family Game Night with the restaurant gift card, a board game, puzzle, and dice.







#### **Online Enrichment Classes**

Eligible members ages 6–18 receive a \$50 gift card per year to enroll in various online classes including but not limited to nutrition, cooking, and fitness-related courses.

#### Clothing

Eligible members ages 0–18 receive a \$100 yearly gift card to purchase clothing from retailers such as Walmart, Old Navy, thrift stores, and other clothing stores.



#### **GED Support**

Members 18 and older can receive up to four vouchers for the GED® test. The GED test covers four subjects.

#### Additional Value-Added Benefits

Value-Added Benefits are available to all members

#### **EMPLOYMENT**

Members can receive vouchers to pay for GED testing and application fees for post-secondary education tests and application fees.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Members have access to transportation to and from medical appointments, pharmacies, and other essential services.

#### YOUTH

Children and adolescents may receive Books, grocery gift cards, youth club membership, sports physicals, and more.

#### **TECHNOLOGY**

Members over age 18 are eligible for a free cell phone with a preloaded suite of digital health apps, increased hearing aid benefits, and 24/7 access to physicians for urgent care needs from a computer, tablet, or smartphone.



Additional Benefits include Personal and Feminine Hygiene products, Home-delivered meals after hospitalization, Home safety items, and Assistance obtaining Identification.
